Trash/Recycle

Bins may only be placed outside Wednesday evening until Thursday evening. Your bins must be stored in your garage at all other times.

Bins must be three feet from building AND other bins. This allows the mechanical arm to operate safely and correctly.

Do not leave any items on the pavement. No boxes, trash bags etc.

Yard waste
